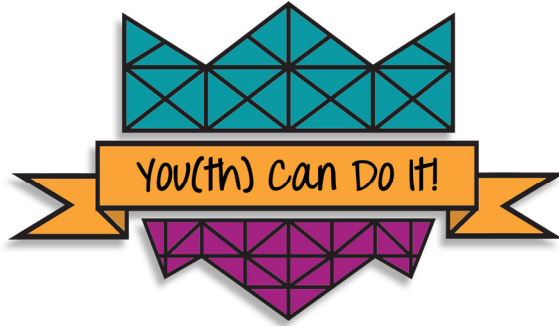

The Pageant will be held in conjunction with the Miss Beautiful SMTX Pageant on June 7, 2019 at the San Marcos Activity Center. There is a \$10 entry fee to participate. Contestants do not have to reside in San Marcos. Prizes will be awarded for Queen/King and First, Second, and Third Runner Up in the following categories: Little Miss Beautiful SMTX, Jr. Miss Beautiful SMTX, Little Mr. San Marvelous, and Jr. Mr. San Marvelous. Awards will also be given for Most Expressive and Most Inspirational based on their confidence, answer to the question, stage presence, and attitude.

During the pageant, contestants will have to answer a short question that will be provided two weeks prior to the event. There will be one semi-formal runway look.

The purpose of this pageant is to provide youth with special needs an opportunity to build confidence and practice self-expression.

## Pageant Information

- Pageant entry fee is \$10 and is due at the time of application submission. Entry fee is non-refundable. A 5"x7" headshot is also due at time of application submission. Payment may be made via check to City of San Marcos or via credit card at 401 E. Hopkins, San Marcos, TX 78666.
- Contestants are responsible for providing their own appropriate semi-formal look. Contestants are responsible for their own hair and makeup. The multi-purpose room will serve as a prep room for all youth contestants. The restroom can be used for changing.
- The contestants will be asked a question. The question will be provided to contestants 2 weeks prior to the pageant.

## Pageant Rules

- Good sportsmanship is required at all times by contestants, parents and guests. Bad sportsmanship is NEVER tolerated. If any contestant, guardian, or guest violates our sportsmanship rules at any time, they will be DISQUALIFIED. Any awards received will be forfeited and they will be asked to leave immediately with no refund. EVERYONE who comes to our pageants has the right to be treated with kindness and respect! **THIS APPLIES TO WORDS OR ACTIONS BEFORE, DURING, OR AFTER THE PAGEANT!**
- Contestant agrees to participate in a run through the day of the pageant at 6:15pm. Those that do not attend the run through will not be allowed to participate.
- All contestants must remain until crowning in order to receive prizes. Any contestant that leaves before crowning forfeits their prizes and no refund will be given.
- Prizes will be awarded for Queen/King and First, Second, and Third Runner Up in the following categories: Little Miss Beautiful SMTX, Jr. Miss Beautiful SMTX, Little Mr. San Marvelous, and Jr. Mr. San Marvelous. Awards will also be given for Most Expressive and Most Inspirational. "Little" contestants are ages 4-12. "Junior" contestants are ages 13-17.
- No one will be allowed backstage on the date of the pageant other than pageant officials, contestants, approved guardian, and others approved by the director to assist the contestants with preparations. All individuals backstage will have appropriate arm bands. No men/boys will be allowed in the female dressing rooms and no females/girls will be allowed in the boys dressing room. Should your guardian be the opposite gender, please make arrangements for the same gender to assist in the dressing room.
- **All decisions of the judges are final.** Do not approach the judges before, during or after the pageant. It is okay to speak with the judges if they approach you. Judges will be people who are not directly affiliated with contestants entering the pageants.
- No information will be given out about the contestant groups or the judges until the day of the pageant.
- Contestants and guests will not be permitted to drink alcoholic beverages, smoke or use foul language at any time during the pageant and must follow all city ordinances and posted rules.
- Contestants and their parents/guardians agree to hold harmless all persons affiliated with the City of San Marcos, in case of any loss or injury occurring during the entire pageant and preparation for the pageant.
- Contestants and their parents / guardians agree that the City of San Marcos may publish any photographs taken at an official event or submitted by the contestant, contestant name, and likeness for use in the organization's print, online (including social media) and video-based marketing materials, as well as other organization publications. Contestants also agree to ride on the Keep San

Marcos Beautiful float in the Veterans Day Parade on November 9, 2019 and assist with handing out awards at the Keep San Marcos Beautiful Awards Ceremony in Spring 2020.
