BULK PICK UP

FOUR PER YEAR

1ST & 3RD FULL WEEK OF THE MONTH

Call by 4 pm two business days before your trash day

Maximum of 3 cubic yards per pick up

Accepted:

- furniture
- appliances (Freon-free)
- carpet (4' rolls)
- lumber (less than 4' long, nail-free)
- yard waste (branches less than 3" wide & 4' long, bundled, under 35 lbs)

COMMUNITY CLEAN UP

750 RIVER RD | 8 AM - 1 PM

2ND SATURDAY OF APRIL, MAY, SEPTEMBER & OCTOBER

Utility bill required for drop-off

No commercial waste

Accepted:

- furniture & mattresses
- appliances & electronics
- scrap metal
- tires
- brush
- household hazardous waste

CURBSIDE CART SERVICE INFORMATION & TIPS

- Carts are serviced 7 am - 7 pm
- Place carts 3 ft apart in an area clear of obstacles (mailboxes, vehicles, trees, utility lines) with the arrows on the lids pointing toward the street
- Return carts to your house or behind a fence by 9 pm on your service day
- If you have a service issue, notify the Resource Recovery office the next business day
- Service calendars are available online

Plastic bags & films are not accepted in the curbside recycling cart



Return to a major retailer:

- Grocery, produce, bread, newspaper & Ziploc bags
- Case & bubble wrap
- Air pillows
- Amazon envelopes

Boxes & Flattened Cardboard



- Items loose; not bagged
- No Styrofoam, plastic bags, soiled paper, food, or liquids
- Empty & rinse containers
- Flatten boxes
- Place extra recycling in a small cardboard box by cart (up to 3 boxes)
- Lid closed

- Material loose
- No plastic bags, plastic-coated paper, soil, sod, or rock
- Place extra yard waste in paper yard bags by cart (up to 12 bags)
